#### **REGISTRATION**

- Registration for Summer Session 2015 opened on February 18. Financial aid for summer cannot be awarded until all required forms and applications including the 2015-2016 FAFSA are received by our office. Students receiving financial aid for the Summer Sessions must be enrolled for a total of 6 hours over all the Summer Sessions (ex. 3 hours Session 1 and 3 hours Session 2 = 6 hours). Students can download the 2015-2016 summer application for financial aid at <a href="https://www.msj.edu/aid-forms">www.msj.edu/aid-forms</a>.
- Students will register for fall semester beginning in April. They received an e-mail with specific dates for advising and registration. Students must meet with their advisors prior to registration. Advising begins March 23.
  Note: Students who have a balance on their student account will receive an e-mail indicating there is a 'registration hold', and that they should contact Student Administrative Services.

Following is the registration schedule:

- Opens for Seniors at 6:00 a.m. April 14
- Opens for Juniors at 6:00 a.m. April 16
- Opens for Sophomores at 6:00 a.m. and 6:30 a.m. April 21
- Opens for Freshmen at 6:00 a.m. and 6:30 a.m. April 23

# **ONLINE BILLING REMINDER**

# Make sure your student has registered and has invited you to register to access his or her student bill!

Our online system for student billing, provides convenience and easy access for our students and parents to manage their student account. Together with Tuition Management Systems (TMS), we integrated the newest technology with our student billing system. This electronic system has replaced the hard copy billing statements and confirmation mailings that were used. Some of the features include:

 Account Summary Data - available 24/7
 Account Activity – also available 24/7
 Statements – view student account statement and options to pay: including enrolling in a payment plan, or making payment by check, EFT, or credit card
 Ability to Share Account Access – students can give access to their parent(s) to view and help manage their account
 Direct Access – through mjs.afford.com for authorized participants Students have received e-mails from <u>msj.@afford.com</u> with important information on how to electronically register and set up profile information. If your student does not have their password, they can go to <u>www.msjafford.com</u> and click on the '**reset password**' link and type in their Mount e-mail address. A temporary password will be sent to their e-mail within 24 hours. This process will only need to be done once. #### SEMESTER GRADES

#### **SCHOLARSHIPS**

For our first-time freshmen who have academic scholarships, please note that grades are not reviewed until the end of the school year. Once final grades are available in May, if the **cumulative** GPA is 3.0 or higher, the scholarship will be renewed automatically for next year. If a student has not earned a 3.0 cumulative GPA, **don't** panic. He or she will still receive the scholarship, but on a **probationary** basis, for fall 2016. If the student earns at least a 3.0 in his or her full-time fall coursework, then he or she will receive the scholarship for the spring semester as well. (The probationary period allows the student an additional semester to demonstrate his/her ability to perform college coursework at the 3.0 level) Please encourage your student to talk to a staff member in the Conlan Center, if there are any questions or concerns regarding scholarships or other financial aid.

#### FAFSA RENEWAL REMINDER

It's FAFSA renewal time! If your student filed a FAFSA for this school year, he or she will need to complete the **2015-2016 FAFSA RENEWAL** online at <u>www.fafsa.ed.gov</u> as soon as possible. They will need for you to provide information from your 2014 tax return. Estimates can be used if you are helping them complete the FAFSA prior to completing your taxes. The student will get a reminder from the U.S. Education Department to review any estimated data after the April 15<sup>th</sup> tax-filing deadline and to make any necessary corrections. We strongly encourage students to file the FAFSA now and no later than May 1<sup>st</sup>.

If you have any questions or need assistance with filing the FAFSA, one of our representatives may be able to help with a quick answer by phone at 513-244-4418 or via e-mail (contacts listed below). If you prefer, individual appointments can be made by calling our office.

We are packaging and awarding financial aid for next year. The sooner we receive the FAFSA, the better. Once your student receives his or her financial aid award letter for next year, we will be happy to help you with reviewing his or her financial aid, out-of-pocket estimates, and payment options.
