She had a rich career practicing medical-surgical, obstetric and gerontology nursing in her home state of West Virginia before continuing her education in graduate nursing. To be eligible for the Catherine Relihan Scholarship, candidates must:

- be accepted to the MN program
- have an admission cumulative GPA of at least 3.4
- submit an application
- submit an essay describing your aspirations for personal and professional development in the program
