The Robert Wood Johnson New Careers in Nursing Scholarship will be awarded to ten students who enter the Master of Nursing program in May, 2010. The scholarships are \$10,000 each. Award preference is given to students from groups underrepresented in nursing or from disadvantaged backgrounds.

Underrepresented groups in nursing are defined as: "individuals from racial/ethnic groups and cultural backgrounds historically under-represented within the nursing community, including but not limited to men, persons of color, individuals with disabilities and those educationally and/or economically disadvantaged."

Disadvantaged background is defined as: "students whose annual income falls below a level defined by Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) for disadvantaged as determined by the information on Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and those who self-report to be first generation college graduates."

To be eligible for the New Careers in Nursing scholarships candidates must:

- be accepted to the MN program for entry in May, 2010
- submit a FAFSA application by March 1, 2010
- submit an essay describing your aspirations for personal and professional development in the program

If chosen, candidates will be invited to be interviewed by a selection committee.

Scholarship recipients are required to:

- participate in a mentoring program (UMAPS: Using Mentors to Assist with Program Success) during the MN program
- attend four sessions of a Leadership Development Series during the MN program
- answer surveys from the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation
