ADMISSION CRITERIA

Applicants must submit:

- A completed graduate application at www.msj.edu/apply.
- A letter of intent.
- A resumé.
- Contact information for two professional references.
- Official college transcripts showing a cumulative GPA of no less than 3.0; a GPA below 3.0 requires completion of the GRE.

FULL-TIME ACCELERATED EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

An accelerated 15-month Master of Arts degree Program with field work and Student Teaching

This intense and fulfilling program prepares students to enter the teaching profession through a learning and fieldwork format. A combination of coursework, two Practicums and a full semester of Student Teaching within the Pre-K-5 grade band immerses students in the teaching experience.

Program Benefits

- 12-hour Science of Teaching Reading core - One of only 18 universities rated at the A+ level by the National Council of Teacher Quality
- Completion of the Ohio Early Childhood Education licensure requirements in only 12 months.
- Master of Arts degree with a Major in Teaching can be completed in three additional months.
- Cohort group meets and works together throughout the program.

Program Details

- The program **begins in May** with four accelerated summer classes that are completed by August.
- During the academic year, students are embedded in 2 Practicums and are enrolled in two accelerated courses at a time.
- As the academic year comes to a close, students start to complete their master's degree course work (including a final integrative project).
- This Program has a Dual License offering. Once the Early Childhood License is earned, one class and one Practicum allows the students to earn the 2nd License in Special Education.

The recommended application deadline for the full-time program is April 1st.

Both programs have options for adding an Ohio Reading Endorsement, Ohio Pre-K Special Needs Endorsement, Ohio Teacher Leader Endorsement, and/or Ohio Gifted Intervention Specialist Endorsement.

PART-TIME EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

A traditional Master of Arts degree Program

The part-time program prepares students to enter the teaching profession through a combination of course work with practicum experiences and student teaching. Students will earn licensure in Early Childhood Education and a Master of Arts degree with a Major in Teaching.

Program Benefits:

- Completion of the Ohio licensure requirements and Master's degree through a part-time commitment.
- Includes options for Ohio Reading Endorsement and/or Ohio Pre-K Special Needs Endorsement.
- Rolling admission; students can take up to five years to complete the part-time licensure and Master of Arts degree program.

Program Details:

- Students can start the program at any point during the year.
- During the academic year, students gain practical experience through 100 hours of practicum experiences during two semesters and 15 weeks of full-time student teaching during another semester.



Initial licensure programs are accredited by the Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation.
