The College Cost Reduction and Access Act of 2007 created the Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant program which will allow eligible students to be awarded up to \$4,000 per year (Maximum \$16,000 during a 4-Year Program). BEYOND THE CLASSROOM

HANDS-ON EXPERIENCE

Field experiences begin sophomore year, with a Service Learning experience in an area school. This continues into the junior year, when students take a practicum in a student's chosen content area. During the senior year, students complete a second practicum experience, followed by a student teaching experience in the subsequent semester.
