- X Pets (unless approved by Office of Disability Services (fines will be assessed for unauthorized animals in the Residence Hall)
- X Lighters (fire hazard)

- X Hot plates, electric grills, toasters, air fryers, or any cooking device with a heated surface (except coffee makers with an automatic shut-off) (fire hazard)
- X Extension cords and power strips not surge protected (fire hazard)
- X LED strip lighting (adhesive damages wall surfaces)
