

MISSION AMBASSADOR AWARD

Mount St. Joseph University is excited to announce the Mission Ambassador Award. The award will provide opportunities for students to serve as student campus ministers through the Office of Mission Integration. Students will serve as leaders of interfaith prayer, assist with student retreat experiences, serve as prayer leaders for our athletic teams, engage in service activities, and assume leadership for other campus ministry events throughout the academic year.

The Mission Ambassador Award is a \$2000 renewable award, \$1,000 per semester. The award is renewable for up to eight (8) consecutive semesters, provided the recipient is enrolled full-time in an undergraduate program, maintains higher than 2.5 grade point average, and is actively involved as a Student Campus Minister.

Criteria to be considered for the award:

- Admitted unconditionally to Mount St. Joseph University for the Fall of 2020 with a 2.5 or higher cumulative grade point average
- Be actively involved in a faith tradition
- Exhibit an openness to persons of other faith traditions
- Request two (2) letters of recommendation:
 - One from a leader of your faith tradition (priest, minister, rabbi, imam, youth pastor, etc.)
 - One from a high school teacher
- Submit a personal essay of not more than 300 words in response to this statement:
"I want to serve as a student campus minister because...."
