



Helping all Veterans in Communities (HAVIC) Scholarship

Purpose of the Award: HAVIC would like to help a student at the Mount that is in financial need.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Must be a current Mount student seeking their first Bachelor's Degree, full or part-time
2. Must be a member of the US Armed forces (active or reserves), a veteran not receiving full GI education benefits, or a dependent
3. If discharged from the military, must have a favorable discharge
4. Must demonstrate financial need
5. Apply by December 15, 2019

Application procedure:

1. Complete HAVIC scholarship form and submit an essay, no longer than one page to HAVIC advisor amy.wolf@msj.edu
 - a. Discuss why you deserve this scholarship, what you would spend it on at the Mount (books, meal plan, tuition, child care at the Mount, etc.), and your financial need.
 - b. Include student ID # in the top right corner of essay. Do not put your name on the essay.
2. Proof of military service or proof of dependence of military member (if applicable).

Please Note: Involvement in athletics **MUST NOT** be mentioned in any responses within this application. Mention of such activities will disqualify applicants due to NCAA DIII regulations prohibiting scholarships of any kind being offered to students based on athletic participation or leadership.

Selection Procedure:

1. Applicants will be reviewed by HAVIC and any other appropriate University Office.
2. Recipients of the award shall be notified by January 6, 2020 through a letter from the HAVIC advisor.
